# Birthday Party Frequently Asked Questions ActivZone Indoor Sports Arena

## Can I bring food and drink?

You can bring any food and (non-alcoholic) drinks you would like for your party! Or if you would prefer, we have a range of food and drink options available from the ActivZone café on the day.

## How early can I come before my booking?

We know our party hosts are keen to set up the perfect birthday bash – so you're welcome to arrive at ActivZone and begin setting up half an hour before your booking is scheduled to begin. Please let your guests know to arrive just before your booking begins.

#### Payment and booking numbers?

Number of attendees is required on the booking form - this can be a close approximation. Final numbers will need to be known at the beginning of your booking so Reception can check your booking in. Payment is due at the end of your booking time. Minimum number to book is 8 children/skaters. Bookings over 40 children/skaters may incur additional staffing costs.

#### Where will my party be?

Your party will be held in the wide-open Party Zone alongside the rink, where you can see all your partygoers skating or playing games on the rink. Depending on your party size, the space may be shared with another party, however this will be clearly marked and ample space for your partygoers is ensured.

# What extras do you have available for my party?

We've got a load of extra equipment available upon request during our private birthday parties booked under the first option! There are hockey sticks and pucks, balls of all kinds, hoops, and limbo! Unfortunately, this extra equipment cannot be set up for birthday parties during public skate sessions.

#### Can I set up my own music playlist during my party?

We encourage private birthday parties to bring along a playlist with all your favourite tunes to play during your party! You can either send us a link to your playlist via email or bring along a phone or tablet to connect with our 3.5mm aux cord (please remember to bring any adapter you might need).

# Can I bring other wheels on the rink?

Unfortunately, other wheels like scooters, skateboards, bikes or other wheeled items are not permitted on the rink due to the safety hazards they pose.
